



# Financial Obligations and Attendance Requirements for the Monteagle-Sewanee Rotary Club

## Financial Obligations

Club dues: \$125.00 for Rotarians who eat and \$80.00 for non-eating Rotarians paid quarterly.

Statements of dues are emailed to your mailbox. Please submit your payment by check to the club treasurer or mail it to Monteagle-Sewanee Rotary, PO Box 336, Monteagle, TN 37356. You may also use PayPal or ACH to pay your dues. We encourage members to pay all dues at the beginning of each Rotary year if that is possible.

Support for the Rotary Foundation: \$27.50 paid quarterly. The Foundation will send a tax receipt to you for your support. Generally, the club deposits funds to the Foundation in March. You may make additional contributions at any time. Many of our members have become Paul Harris Fellows once or multiple times. This signifies that their lifetime giving has exceeded \$1,000.

Cost of meals: \$11.00 for your guests and for non-eating Rotarians attending a breakfast meeting paid to the Treasurer or Sergeant at Arms on the day of the meal. If your guest is actively considering Rotary membership, their first meal is not charged.

Socials: The cost for Rotarians attending socials is included in the dues. Guests of Rotarians and non-eating Rotarians will pay a charge determined by the social committee. Prospective members are guests of the club.

## Other Financial Considerations

You are encouraged but not required to purchase tickets and/or register for Rotary sponsored events such as the Golf Tournament, the Cajun Supper, and the Hunger Walk. .

## Attendance Requirements

All Rotary clubs encourage a minimum of 50 percent attendance. The Monteagle-Sewanee Rotary Club accepts this standard, which means that as a member of our club, you are expected to attend at least 50 percent of all club meetings in a six-month period. Our club averages 70-75% attendance at meetings.

## Attendance Options

If you're unable to attend a meeting, you can make up that meeting by attending a meeting of another Rotary club. For instance, if you're on a business trip, you might attend a Rotary club meeting in another city. You can also make up a meeting by attending an e-club meeting online.
